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Summary

Dear Applicant,

Westrec Marinas, Manager of the Chicago Park District's 10 harbors, is pleased to provide you with information pertaining to the availability of new commercial docking stalls for the 2019 boating season.

In 2018, Westrec Marinas installed several new fingers to B Dock in DuSable Harbor, creating several new 50-foot and 70-foot stalls. For the 2019 season, these new stalls will be provided utilities similar to the utilities existing in other DuSable stalls, including water and 50 Amp – 208-volt power. One 50-foot stall and one 70-foot stall are being made available for Dealer Commercial permittees.

All questions must be submitted in writing by March 8, 2019 at 1:00 pm. Questions may also be emailed to bids@chicagoharbors.com. Please include the title and number of the NOA with all questions submitted.

If you are interested in the opportunity to operate in one of the available locations, then read carefully, complete the attached "Notice of Availability" application and submit it to Westrec Marinas no later than 3:00 p.m. on March 22, 2019.

Applications must be submitted to Westrec Marinas, 1521 S. Linn White Drive, 1st Floor South, Chicago, IL 60605.

After the application deadline, you will be contacted within twenty (20) days regarding the status of your application. The application review and selection process, including the criteria used in reviewing the applications are explained within this packet. 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General Conditions

Westrec Marinas has identified two spaces for Dealer commercial boating activities in the DuSable Harbor. These are designated as:

1. B-02 (ISTB002) a 50-foot walk on stall
2. B-03 (ISTB003) a 70-foot walk on stall

Minimum bid for space B-02 is \$11,000.00 per season

Minimum bid for space B-03 is \$18,000.00 per season

You may bid on one or both spaces.

- Payment for 2019 season will be due as follows:
 - One-third due by April 15, 2019
 - One-third due by June 15, 2019
 - Balance due by August 15, 2019
- Payments for each subsequent season are due as follows:
 - One-third due by December 15th preceding the season
 - One-third due by February 15th preceding the season
 - Balance due by April 15th preceding the season
- Commercial docking activities are allowed from May 1st to October 31st.
- Applicant must comply with all CPD and harbor rules.
- Applicant must have a Chicago Park District Dealer Commercial Permit, including any applicable local, state or federal permits or licenses.
- Application for the Chicago Park District Dealer Commercial Permit may be found at <https://www.chicagoharbors.info/forms>
- Dealer Commercial Permit fee is not included in bid.
- One parking pass included with slip.
- Stalls are for purposes of dealer displaying boats for sale by dealer.
- Dealer must notify DuSable Marina Manager of boats to occupy dealer stalls.
- Stalls may not be utilized for non-dealer boats, for rent or otherwise sub-leased.
- If a dealer sells a boat during the harbor season:
 - The boat sold may remain in the dealer stall for the remainder of that harbor season only.
 - Dealer remains the permittee and remains responsible for ensuring compliance with CPD and harbor rules.
 - Purchaser of the boat is not entitled to parking cards, except those the dealer may loan to purchaser.
- Harbor reserves the right to utilize stalls for transient dockage or other purposes when stall is vacant.
- All spaces are provided in "as-is" condition.
- Awards and/or permits are non-transferable

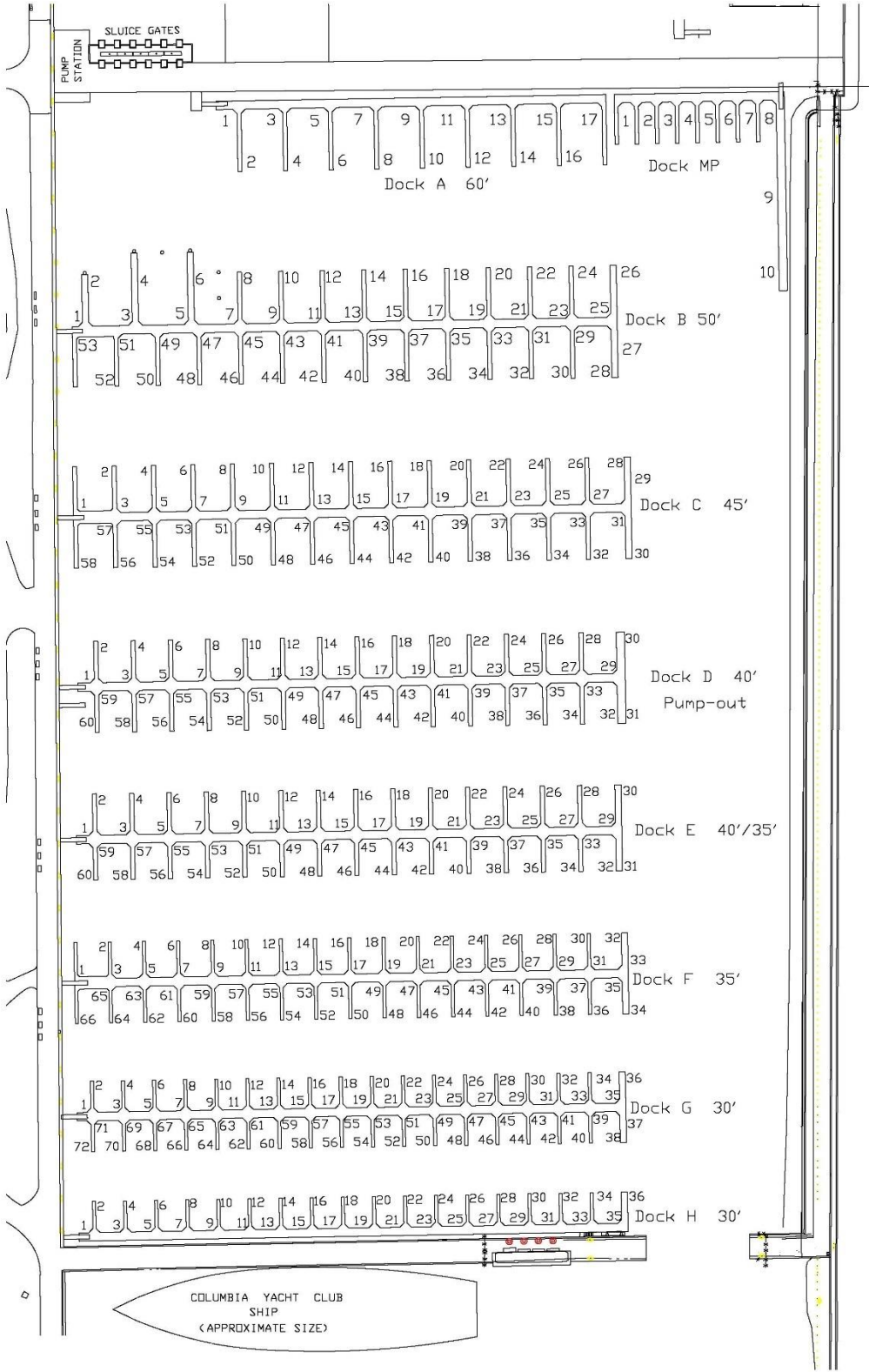


Figure 1-For reference only

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Submittal

Please provide a submittal package including the documents listed below. Each submittal package must include:

1. A signed Bid Page (Page 6 of this Document)
2. A signed Signature Page (Page 7 of this document)
3. Description of Bidder including past experience, business plan, and any other information the bidder believes is relevant.

Each submittal package should be in a sealed envelope and must be received at the Westrec Marinas Offices at 1521 S. Linn White Drive, 1st Floor South, Chicago, IL 60605 no later than 3:00 p.m. on March 22, 2019. Bidder is solely responsible for delivery by due date and time.

Selection

The selection process will involve four steps.

1. A staff committee will review all submittals and determine submittals to advance to the semi-finals for interviews.
2. The Committee will interview the semi-finalists. The interviews will provide an opportunity for the parties to share detailed information about proposed information and the experience of the bidder.
3. The staff will review the preliminary proposals and recommend selected bidders to the Chicago Park District.
4. If approved by the Chicago Park District, the Chicago Harbors staff will enter into contracts with the selected bidders.

Selection will be based on the revenue to the Chicago Park District, bidder's business plan, experience and any other criteria determined to be applicable by the staff.
